

Safety Instructions for the OSDi LiveGuide Services

By installing and using the OSDi LiveGuide software you consent to these Safety Instructions. If you do not consent to these provisions, you are not entitled to install or otherwise use the software.

The use of the OSDi LiveGuide software via browser or application (the “app”) allows instructions or recommendations to be remotely exchanged between several persons via a mobile device. The electrical and/or mechanical operation of machines, systems, and tools may pose hazards in the respective area of activity.

As a result, please make sure that the following safety requirements are met before you use the Service:

- Make sure that the operating instructions of the machines and tools in use are available and that you have read and understood their contents, especially the safety instructions.
- Make sure that the operator’s risk assessments for the applicable activities are known and are taken into account.
- Do not carry out activities that you are not authorized to carry out or for which you are not sufficiently qualified.
- Make sure that you can carry out the necessary activities on the machine, system, or tools.
- Before using the app, check the relevant area of activity and remove potential hazards or take precautions to prevent risks.
- Please bear in mind that you are distracted when using the mobile device (e.g. smartphones) and remove all potential hazards.
- Do not execute any instructions that you have not correctly understood and in which you feel uncertain.
- If you are using the app with data glasses, familiarize yourself with the use of the device and only use it if you can safely execute the instructions.
- Data glasses influence your field of vision and your perception through a display. Make sure that you can still adequately perceive your environment. Take care during use and stop using the device in case of doubt.
- If potential hazards arise, immediately remove the data glasses and place the mobile device aside so that your hands are free.
